| Jackpot Classes: | \$10.00 Entry Fee – 100% Payback of Entry Fees Plus \$50.00 Added Purse Split: 40% - 25% - 20% - 10% - 5% for First Five Places | 2. Horses 58" and over. Registered Horse Breed under 58" must Provide Papers. |

| Contest Classes: | \$5.00 Entry Fee – Electric Timer Fee \$2.00 | 4. Five horses constitute a class. Show Committee reserves the right to combine or change classes if necessary. |
