## GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Entry Fees:** \$5.00 - Entries To Be Made at Show Ring Day of Show
- \*\*\*Please note the show starts at 8:30 A.M.
- \*\*\*Warm-up ring will be open during the Jump Classes only to those entered in the Jumping Classes. Warm-up jumps will be flagged and mus be jumped in the indicated direction only. Warm-up jumps may not be moved.
- Jackpot Classes:** \$10.00 Entry Fee - 100% Payback Plus \$50.00 added. Purse Split: 40% - 25% - 20% - 10% - 5% for first five places Not to count toward High Point. No Trophy Awarded.
- Cross Rails Class:** Open to Riders and Horses of very limited ability. Not open to any Walk/Trot Horses or Riders, may not go in any other jump classes, except #9. Not to count toward High Point. No Trophy Awarded.
- Awards:** Trophy and 5 Ribbons per Class. High Point Awarded for Same Horse and Rider Accumulating the Most Points. High Point Award will be separated as Follows:  
SADDLE SEAT High Point Classes: 1,12,16,20  
HUNT SEAT High Point Classes: 2, 13/17,21/22, 24  
WALK/TROT High Point Classes: 3, 10/11,14/15,19  
OVER FENCES CLASSES: 5/7, 6, 8, 9

1. All Classes Are HORSE ONLY.
2. Horses 58" and over. Registered Horse Breed under 58" must Provide Papers.
3. Rider's age determined as of January 1.
4. Five horses constitute a class. Show Committee reserves the right to combine or change classes if necessary.
5. Proper attire required in all classes. Helmets with harness required in all over fences classes.
6. NO REFUNDS, unless approved by a veterinarian.
7. Any additional intermissions will be at the discretion of the Show Committee.
8. Liability release must be signed.
9. Judge's Decision is Final.
10. Green Horse is any horse that has not been shown at over 3'. Not eligible for Regular Working Hunter Classes 7 and 17.
11. Walk/Trot Classes are open to those who have not shown in any canter classes. May enter Walk/Trot classes ONLY.
12. Stallion may be shown, but only by a person over 18 years old.
13. WARM UP AREA CLOSED TO ALL BUT THOSE ENTERED IN OVER FENCES CLASSES FROM CLASS #4-8.
14. All horses may be subject to inspection by official fair veterinarian at time of entrance to the grounds.
15. The management reserves the right to take any additional measures to protect the health of horses shown at the Fair.
16. All exhibitors must follow Animal health Rules on Page 67.
17. **Any electric cord used on the fairgrounds has to be 3 wire 14 gauge UL approved.**

**ALL trucks or trailers carrying horses will enter the grounds by way of Gate 8.  
This is the ONLY gate that will admit horses.**
