



THE GREAT GEAUGA COUNTY FAIR CAMPERS – 2025 SEASON

Thank you for joining us in celebrating our **203rd fair!** We are excited about this year's event and have worked hard to update the **Campground Rules and Regulations** to ensure a safe and comfortable experience for everyone. We ask all families to take the time to review these regulations carefully.

Each year, interest in securing a campsite continues to grow. We strive to make the process as fair as possible while ensuring that the fairboard can complete necessary repairs and upgrades to the campground. **This year, the campsite fee has been raised to \$170**, which includes two car passes, a camping permit, and a 30-amp electrical outlet per site. We hope that everyone will appreciate the convenience of two car passes.

To help maintain order, we remind all campers that **vehicles must be parked within their designated site**. To avoid any issues with towing, please be mindful of this rule and sign the attached form acknowledging your agreement.

ONLINE APPLICATION PROCESS







To apply online, visit geaugafair.com/campgrounds or scan the QR Code. Select the "Campsite Permit" option and click "**Buy Now.**" You will then be directed to the campground application page. Please have the following items ready:

1. Your site number (found on the application included with this letter).
2. Proof of liability insurance – see "Proof of Liability Insurance" below.



After submitting your form, the final step is to provide payment information. **All applications are reviewed, and only one site may be purchased at this time.**

IMPORTANT DATES – 2025

-  **Wednesday, June 11** – Campground application deadline
-  **Wednesday, June 25** – Open to new reservations & returning campers may switch sites
-  **Wednesday, July 16** – Deadline for switching sites
-  **Saturday, August 16** – Campground setup begins
-  **Wednesday, August 20** – Campground packet pickup available
-  **Wednesday, August 27** – Electric service turned on for campsites


THE GREAT GEAUGA COUNTY FAIR CAMPERS – 2025 SEASON - CONTINUED

- Campground packets must be picked up at the Fair Office.
- If you purchase a fair membership with your campground permit, you must show proof of age and Geauga County residence to receive the membership.
- Please read the Campground Rules and Regulations insert – there are updates.
- To process and reserve a site, you must return the campground application, payment in full, proof of liability insurance. Any incomplete application or missing paperwork will be put into the “problem file” without notice to applicant and the site will not be reserved.
- We no longer accept any paperwork by email. Please make sure to drop off at the office, mail to the office or apply online.

PROOF OF LIABILITY INSURANCE

Proof of liability insurance is typically found on the Declaration Page of your homeowner’s insurance policy. It must include the following:




1. Name of the campground applicant.
2. Applicant’s current address (matching the campground application).
3. Current policy dates. (If your policy expires before the fair starts, you must provide an updated copy when picking up your campground packet.)
4. Stated personal liability amount.

 Car insurance does NOT meet the requirement unless it specifically includes vacation liability for your camping unit.

No applications will be processed without proper proof of insurance.
