General Terms & Conditions

Entry Fees (to be made at Show Ring Day of Show)

Regular Classes \$8 - - - - - Jackpot Classes \$10 - - - - - Contesting Classes \$10 (includes \$2 timer fee)

Awards

Regular Classes - Trophy and 5 Ribbons

Jackpot Classes – 100% payback plus \$50 added. Purse split 40% - 25% - 20% - 10% - 5% for first five places

Contesting Classes – 80% payback. Purse split 45% - 25% - 10% for first 3 places

High Point & Reserve High Point awarded for Same Horse and Rider accumulating the most points in **Walk/Trot Western, Walk/Trot English, Western, English & Contesting**

1. Classes are open to equine of all sizes.
2. Rider's age determined as of January 1st.
3. Five horses constitute a class. The show committee reserve the right to combine or change classes if necessary.
4. Proper attire required for all classes.
5. NO REFUNDS, unless approved by veterinarian.
6. Any additional intermissions will be at the direction of the Show Committee.
7. Liability release must be signed on entry card.
8. The judge's decision is FINAL.
9. Walk/Trot classes are open to those who have not shown in any canter classes. Walk/Trot exhibitors may not enter any cantering classes. Open class exhibitors may not enter any walk/trot classes.
10. Stallions may be shown, but only by a person over 18 years old.
11. Horses may be subject to inspection by an official fair veterinarian at time of entrance to the grounds.
12. We reserve the right to take any additional measures to protect the health of horses shown at the fair. All exhibitors must follow Animal Health Rules.
13. No stalls will be provided for the open shows except those registered for Junior Fair
14. HAUL-INS WELCOME -- ALL trucks or trailers carrying horses will enter the grounds by way of Gate 8. This is the ONLY gate that will admit horses for the show.
