Entry Fees:	\$8.00 – Entries To Be Made at Show Ring Day of Show
Jackpot Classes 1 & 6:	10.00 Entry Fee – $100%$ Payback of Entry Fees Plus 50.00 added. Purse Split: $40%$ - $25%$ - $20%$ - $10%$ - $5%$ for First Five places.
<u>Contest Classes:</u> 23, 24, 27	\$8.00 Entry Fee – Electric Timer Fee \$2.00 80% Payback of Entry Fee. Purse Split: 45% - 25% - 10% - 5% for First Three places.
<u>Awards:</u>	Trophy and 5 Ribbons per Class. High Point Award and Reserve Ribbon Awarded for Same Horse and Rider Accumulating the Most Point. High Point Award will be separated as Follows: WALK / TROT WESTERN CONTESTING RANCH
<u>Note</u> :	Jackpot Classes and Contest Classes will not have trophies. Jackpot Classes will not be awarded points towards High Point Awards.

- 1. All Classes Are HORSE ONLY.
- 2 Horses 58" and over. Registered Horse Breed under 58" must Provide Papers.
- 3. Rider's age determined as of January 1.
- 4. Five horses constitute a class. Show Committee reserves the right to combine or change classes if necessary.
- 5. Proper attire required in all classes.
- 6. NO REFUNDS, unless approved by a veterinarian.
- 7. Any additional intermissions will be at the discretion of the Show Committee.
- 8. Liability release must be signed.
- 9. Judge's decision is FINAL.
- Walk/Trot classes are open to those who have not shown in any canter classes. May enter Walk/Trot classes ONLY.
- 11. Stallion may be shown, but only by a person over 18 years old.
- 12. Horses may be subject to inspection by official fair veterinarian at time of entrance to the grounds.
- 13. The management reserves the right to take any additional measures to protect the health of horses shown at the fair.
- 14. All exhibitors must follow Animal Health Rules.
- No stalls will be provided for the open shows except for registered Jr. Fair exhibitors currently stalled on the grounds.

ALL trucks or trailers carrying horses will enter the grounds by way of Gate 8. This is the ONLY gate that will admit horses for the shows.
