



Geauga County Junior Fair Livestock Sales Scholarship

- 1) A Scholarship is available to any Junior Fair member who has participated in the Geauga County Junior Fair Livestock Sale for a minimum of four (4) years.
- 2) The applicant must be attending a four (4) year college, two (2) year college, or vocational school in the fall of the application year.
- 3) The recipient(s) of the scholarship will be determined according to participation in 4-H (including number of years and offices held), extra-curricular activities, and community service. An interview may be required before selection is made.
- 4) The application must be completed and accompanied by an essay that is dated and signed by the applicant. The body of the essay must contain two hundred and fifty (250) words or more on your personal learning experience from participation in the Junior Fair livestock program.
- 5) Junior Fair participants may apply an unlimited number of times up to the age of twenty four (24), but may only be awarded this scholarship one (1) time.
- 6) All applications for this scholarship must be postmarked by August 1st of the application year and sent to:

- 7) Scholarship selection will be chosen by three (3) members of the scholarship committee. No one on the selection committee may be related to any of the applicants.
- 8) The current year's recipient(s) will be announced Saturday night at the Geauga County Junior Fair Livestock Auction, one-half (1/2) hour prior to the small animal auction in the small tent and one-half (1/2) hour prior to the large animal sale in the arena.
- 9) The value of the scholarship will be determined by the number of qualified applicants and the funds available in the scholarship account. The scholarship award check will be made out to the recipient and presented at the Geauga County Agricultural Society's annual meeting.
- 10) The decisions of the Geauga County Junior Fair shall be considered final.
