Preparing for The Great Geauga County Fair Junior Fair Royal Court Competition

Read this before completing your application forms.

Your application is the first impression the judges will have of you. WRITE NEATLY! Use a pen or download as a PDF and type your responses. Check your spelling. Have someone proofread your application for you. Make sure your email address and phone number are legible.

Requirements to Participate:

- Must be at least 16, and no older than 18 years old as of January 1 of the current year.
- Must be in high school, have graduated from high school or completed a GED.
- Not now or ever have been married.
- Not now or ever have been pregnant or adopted a child.
- No use/consumption of illegal substances or alcohol.
- Never have been convicted of a criminal offense or have criminal charges pending.
- If you are chosen as Junior Fair Queen, you are required to represent our fair at the OFMA convention in Columbus in January and compete for Ohio Fairs Queen.
- Please be aware that the competition rules for the Ohio Fairs Queen require that all tattoos be covered. Please take that into consideration should you be chosen as Junior Fair Queen.

Interview Expectations:

- Complete all information on the application. Do not attach a resume.
- Think of how you want to represent our fair. Can you share something unique?
- Wear appropriate wardrobe and at your interview. Professional attire is recommended.
- Arrive a few minutes before your scheduled time. If you cannot make your scheduled time, contact Nancy Parker at nancydavidparker@gmail.com or 440-221-4475 as soon as possible.
- Use appropriate language. Make eye contact.
- Be yourself! Be confident!
- Be appropriate on social media at all times.
